About

The 2017 Michigander takes place from July 15-22, 2017, and offers three tour options:

- 2-Day Weekend (July 15-16) Designed for ease, approximately 25-30 miles a day
- 6-Day Tour (July 17-22) For those who like to ride 50-60 miles a day
- 8-day Tour (July 15-22) Combines the 2-Weekend and 6-Day Tour

Accommodations

The first two days, you will be with the 2-Day weekend Ride in Traverse City and then move to Frankfort for to begin the 6-Day Ride. All will need to drive their vehicles from Traverse City to Frankfort after the ride on Sunday, July 16. Deadlines

Registration Deadlines

- Online registration opens January 25, 2017 and closes June 30, 2017.
- Paper registration opens February 5, 2017 and closes May 1, 2017.
- We must receive payment for paper registrations by May 1, 2017, otherwise, you must register online.
- There are no late registration fees, just join us.

Cancellations & Refunds

- The last day to cancel and receive a refund is midnight, June 15, 2017
- When paying by check, your refund will be processed less the \$36 cancellation fee within 30 days of your cancellation request. Your refund check will be made out to the person on this form and mailed to the address provided on this form.

What is included with registration?

Where do our registration fees go?

- Logistics. It takes staff hundreds of hours of planning; securing permits with local, regional, state and federal agencies.
- Ride amenities; catering, provisioned rest stops, camping fees, park entry fees, shower trucks, port-a-johns, motor vehicle fleet, luggage transfer, comprehensive trip literature, gratuities for scheduled events and activities, permits, route planning, advanced route checking, pre-ride route marking and route marking supplies, post ride route marking removal, daily ride vehicle support, mechanical and first aid support, scheduled entertainment and activities, and last minute pop up expenses.

When can we arrive to set up camp?

- 2-Day and 8-Day Rides may arrive early to camp after 6:00 p.m., Friday, July 14, 2017.
 - Note: there are no meals on Friday, July 14, 2017, visit www.traversecity.com for options.
- 6-Day riders may arrive early to camp after 6:00 p.m., Sunday, July 17, 2017.
 - Note: there are no meals for 6-Day Riders on Sunday, July 16, visit www.visitbenzie.com for options.

Where does the ride begin and end?

- 2-Day Ride:
 - The 2-Day begins and ends at Grand Traverse County Civic Center.
- 6-Day Ride:
 - The 6-Day begins and ends at Frankfort High School.
- 8-Day Ride:
 - The 8-Day will begin at Grand Traverse County Civic Center, and the 6-Day portion of the ride will begin and end at Frankfort High School.

Where do we park our cars?

- 2-Day: Grand Traverse County Civic Center
- 6-Day: Frankfort High School
- 8-Day: Grand Traverse County Civic Center July 14-15 and Frankfort High School July 16-22

Shopping:

- You can order Michigander Ride Wear until May 1, 2017. Michigan 6% sales tax will be assessed to each order.
- We will distribute all merchandise during registration on the ride.
- Michigander Pint Glasses should be stored in your vehicle to ensure they do not get damaged on the ride.

Michigander Century Ride \$15 per person

The Michigander Century Ride (100 miles) takes place on Thursday, July 20, 2017. The ride will depart in Leland and end at Grand Traverse County Civic Center in Traverse City. We need a minimum of 20 cyclists to support this century ride by May 1 in order to pull the necessary permits.

The tour will pick up at the Grand Traverse County Civic Center on Thursday, July 10 at 3:30 p.m. and will return between 7:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. that evening.
