

Michigander Paper Registration

About

The 2019 Michigander takes place from July 13-18, 2019, and offers two tour options:

- 2-Day Tour (July 13-15) Designed for ease, approximately 25-30 miles a day
- 6-Day Tour (July 13-18) For those who like to ride 50-60 miles a day

Routes feature a mix of paved trails, backroads, crushed limestone surfaced trails and on one occasion hard-pack dirt road.

Deadlines

- January 31: Registration Opens
- February 15: Paper Registration is available for those who prefer to pay by check between February 15 and April 15.
- May 1: Paper registrations with payment by check closes.
- May 9: Preorder Ride Jerseys, Tanks and Hoodies close.



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- May 9: Preorder T-Shirts close.
- June 1: No refunds.
- June 30: Registration closes.

Where do our registration fees go?

- Logistics. It takes staff hundreds of hours of planning; securing permits with local, regional, state and federal agencies.
- Ride amenities; catering, provisioned rest stops, camping fees, park entry fees, shower trucks, porta johns, motor vehicle fleet, luggage transfer, comprehensive trip literature, gratuities for scheduled events and activities, permits, route planning, advanced route checking, pre ride route marking and route marking supplies, post ride route marking removal, daily ride vehicle support, mechanical and first aid support, scheduled entertainment and activities, and last minute pop up expenses.

When can we arrive to set up camp?

- 2-Day riders may arrive to camp on July 12 after 6pm
- 6-Day riders are bussed from Evert High School to Tawas City Elementary School
 - Riders must be at Evert High School by 5pm on July 12

Where does the ride begin and end?

- 2-Day Ride:
 - The 2-Day begins and ends at Tawas City Elementary School.
- 6-Day Ride:
 - The 6-Day begins at Tawas City Elementary School and ends at Evert High School.

Routes and Schedule

2019 Tentative Michigander Schedule

- **Friday, July 12** - 6-day riders bussed from Evert HS to Tawas City (2-day and 6-day riders can camp in Tawas City)



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- **Saturday, July 13** - Travel out and back from Clara Bolen Elementary School south to the Singing Bridge in Whitney Township
- **Sunday, July 14** - Travel in a loop from Clara Bolen Elementary School north to Oscoda and west to Lumberman's Monument (weekend riders finish)
- **Monday, July 15** - Travel west from Clara Bolen Elementary School to Rifle River Recreation Area (6-Day riders continue tour)
- **Tuesday, July 16** - Travel west to Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center on Higgins Lake
- **Wednesday, July 17** - Travel west to Cadillac High School near William Mitchell State Park
- **Thursday, July 18** - Travel south to Reed City and east to Evert High School

All Michigander routes will be marked with pins and all turns will be clearly indicated. All tour participants will be invited to join our Michigander 2019 event on Ride with GPS, which will allow you to download daily route maps and cue sheets. You will be able to use these daily routes on your mobile device in an off-line mode including turn by turn instructions if desired. Know that routes are tentative as we are tweaking them as we work with the county road commissions and police departments to ensure a great and safe ride.

All registrants will be provided with daily cue sheets with printed routes along with things to see and do along the way. This is primarily a trail ride, with some days where we utilize roads.

Add-Ons and Guest Registration

Guest Registration

Registration is available for a non-rider spouse, partner, and friends of registered riders only. This includes all camp amenities and meals. Please note: we do not provide shuttle service, this means your guest will be responsible to get from one camp to the next on the 6-Day Tour. We will ensure there is a parking space at each venue for their vehicle (car or van).

If your guest is planning on bringing a camper or RV, please email us for availability as it is very limited and must be arranged prior to arriving on site. Unlike previous years, this year, we happen to have some availability for additional campers and RVs on a first come, first served basis. Know that there will be no electricity available or pump out facilities at the schools where we camp. For a directory of regional campgrounds to pump out or as an alternate camping space for your camper or RV should you decide you require electricity, visit www.michigan.org.

Meal Plans

We do offer a meal plan to non-riders. This is for guests that are not camping or staying on site but that would like to join you at mealtime only. Perfect for those staying in hotels.

2-Day Meal Plan Adult

\$30 per adult-includes 1 dinner buffet on Saturday and one breakfast buffet on Sunday.

2-Day Meal Plan Youth

\$15 per youth (age 7-12) -includes 1 dinner buffet on Saturday and one breakfast buffet on Sunday. Free for age 0-6.

6-Day Meal Plan Adult

6-Day Michigander Meal Package: \$140 per adult, includes 6 breakfast buffets; Saturday through Thursday and 5 dinner buffets; Saturday through Thursday.

6-Day Meal Plan Youth

6-Day Michigander Meal Package: \$108.00 per youth (age 7-12), includes 6 breakfast buffets; Saturday through Thursday and 5 dinner buffets; Saturday through Thursday. Free for age 0-6.

Single Breakfast and Dinner

Guest Meal Pricing for non-riders:

- Breakfast: \$10 per adult, \$5 child 7-13, free for age 0-6
- Dinner: \$15 per person \$8 child 7-13, free for age 0-6

Bus Transportation from Ewart to Tawas

- \$24 per person
- The 2019 Michigander is a loop and we are busing all 6-day riders from the end of the ride in Ewart to the beginning of the ride in Tawas City. Due to logistics, 6-day riders will not be able to park in Tawas City, so all 6-day riders not taking the bus must be dropped off in Tawas City. All 6-day riders using the bus can park their car in Ewart for the duration of the tour at no additional cost.
